**Woodville update - FCA press release of 07/10/2025**

Following the FCA's report published yesterday, below are the key headlines. A full report will follow over the coming days.

Salient points:

All Discretionary Commission Arrangements (DCA) will be paying out, aside from a very small number which don't meet the criteria.

It has been confirmed that there will be an opt-in/opt-out redress scheme.

Fixed fee / fixed commission arrangements, meeting a certain criteria now to be paid out.

A minimum of 14m claims are thought to be eligible for redress.

A note regarding the well publicised '£700' per case value. Please see the first point above. All DCA cases can now be claimed, this includes lower value claims, which in turn brings the average thought to be paid out down to £700. Woodville's lending model carried strict criteria on each and every case we lent on, which will result in a significantly higher value per case.
