**RE: Woodville 2022 Accounts**

We are delighted to finally report on the 2022 accounts from Woodville Consultants and once again to you all, apologies for the delay in the release.

To recap, we saw extensive delays in their publication, purely down to the complexities of the recording of currency exchange of US and Euro investors which of course in 2021 / 2022 was new to us as a company. This delay will not occur in the future as when we undertook this exercise with the accountants for the filing up to 2022, we also dealt with the 2023 and 2024 ledgers so they were also brought up to date.

We have always reported that the 2022 accounts would not be audited, exemptions for small businesses meant this was not a requirement. However, there seems to have been some confusion in the communication of this information to you. We have always stated that forthcoming accounts were to be audited, and this is indeed correct but this is referencing 2023 and 2024 accounts and as soon as 2023 becomes available, you will of course be forwarded a copy.

Our accountants have requested that Companies House agree to a later filing date of the 27th of March 2025, giving our accountants and Carston's time to complete the 2023 figures. All parties have agreed to the end of March as a realistic timeframe for completion of the audit. They will of course be seeking to file as early as possible but suggest the end of March just to be prudent.

As we grow as a company we consistently strive to improve and learn from your generous feedback, one of which was to strengthen our accounting partners, as a result, we intend to engage the services of Grant Thornton to prepare and file our 2024 audited accounts.

Aside from the audit query that has arisen on numerous occasions, we are delighted that 2022 saw a net profit of over £4m demonstrating the continued success and growth of the company, continuing this growth and profitability over 2023 and 2024. Of course, this could not be achieved without the incredible support from all of you, for which we are enormously grateful.

As a company we continue to quickly grow in the ever-changing litigation funding world and as I am sure you have all seen we eagerly await the rollout of the FOS scheme within the PCP space and are very much looking forward to a wonderful 2025.
